

MANDATE

The Undersigned, “STAND FOR OUR PARENTS, The Family Representatives Organization of the ICTR/MICT Detainees undergoing their prison sentences in the Republic of Benin and Senegal and the Acquitted and Released persons in the safe-house in Niger, hereby give this Mandate to the International Lawyers **Charles A. Taku and Beth S. Lyons** in order to act on behalf of the ICTR/MICT Detainees, Acquitted and Released Persons and their families before the international community and relevant international organizations in order to oppose the transfer of these Detainees, Acquitted and Released Persons to the Prisons of the Government of Rwanda.

The mandate is including but not limited to the following:

1. To oppose by legal means any decision by the Security Council of the United Nations to transfer the ICTR/MICT Detained, Acquitted and Released Persons to Rwandan prisons,
2. To engage with the Security Council members to explain the particular sensitive nature of the case of the ICTR/MICT Detained, Acquitted and Released Persons,
3. To inform the Security Council, the United Nations and other relevant International Organizations on the danger the UN Detained, Acquitted and Released Persons will face in case they are transferred to Rwanda,
4. To plead before the Benin, Senegal and Niger Representatives to the UN in New York and elsewhere in order to halt the attempt to transfer the UN detained, acquitted and released persons to Rwanda prisons,
5. To plead before the Security Council and the UN Member States in order to urge the UN to take its responsibilities to search for solutions for the acquitted people and the released people who have completed their sentences currently in a safe-house in Niger, and to continue to provide financial assistance until safe and secure countries are found to host them. Under no circumstances, should the Acquitted and Released people be transferred to Rwanda
6. To report regularly to the President of the Executive Committee of “STAND FOR OUR PARENTS”


Duration:

This mandate is given from the date of its signature, and shall stay in force for six (6) months, renewable for the same period of time.
